

SUMMER READING TIPS

PLAY LETTER/SOUND GAMES:

*Sort pictures/objects by beginning/ending sounds

*Play "I Spy something that begins with ___ sound"

*Play "I'm going camping and I'm packing ___"
(pick words that all have the same beginning sound)

*Write words/letters in sand

*Write words outside with chalk and have child use squirt gun to "erase" words that you give them. It will help them learn to recognize sight words/high frequency words

ORAL READING TIME:

*Spend some time each day reading. You can read to your child, or your child can read to you

*Choral Reading: read together at the same time

*Take turns reading sentences

*Echo reading: adult reads passage and then child repeats that passage

*Repeated reading: reread books!
