I previously taught fourth and second grades, and have made my home in kindergarten for the past nine years. My husband, Dave, and I have been married for 30 years. In history we will study Native Americans, Columbus, the Pilgrims, colonial life, and Mount Rushmore. In geography we will "travel" to all seven continents and end up back here in good old Michigan! Of course, let's not forget all the great hands-on math activities!

Interwoven with our regular curriculum, I will also be teaching mindfulness practices, which I have been studying and implementing over the past three years. Mindfulness is more than just another newfangled catchword to me. I've found it to be very valuable in my own life and want to share it with everyone I know, especially my little friends at school. What is mindfulness? Simply put, it is being in the present moment with awareness, building kindness and compassion for oneself and others, and practicing self-regulation. If you are interested in learning more, the text I'll be working from is the *Mind-Up Curriculum (K-2)* by the Hawn Foundation, which dovetails beautifully with our curriculum and Core Virtues program.
