## Sports eligibility:

Sports eligibility will begin next week, September 10<sup>th</sup>, for all of the fall sport student-athletes. For those in grades 7<sup>th</sup> thru 12<sup>th</sup> that earn a grade below a 78%, he/she will receive a sports eligibility letter on Tuesday morning of that week. ***The sports eligibility letter will need to be signed by the student-athlete, their parent and their coach and be turned in during study hall no later than Thursday of that week.*** Study hall is required at lunch for 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grades on Tuesdays and Thursdays while 9<sup>th</sup> thru 12<sup>th</sup> grades are required to attend Tuesdays thru Fridays. If a grade were to fall below a 60% then the student-athlete is ineligible to participate in any competitions or scrimmages, Monday thru Sunday, of that week.
