If you want to stay and walk with us, please plan to leave your vehicle in the mid-town parking lot which is directly east of the Hillsdale Community Library parking lot.

Teachers will be on-hand Friday morning on campus to transport student drivers and before school care children. WCA office staff has contacted Dial-A-Ride and has asked that all of our morning riders be dropped off at the library for our special day.

High school students will be paired with younger students to support our journey. We will use sidewalks as we travel south on Manning Street, west on South Street and southwest on Reading Avenue. We will have law enforcement escort as we finish our trek travelling west on Hallett Road to campus.

We can't wait until Walk to School Day! See you Friday, October 15th in the lower library parking lot for drop off.
