We have circles on the floor in the classroom for spots while lining up to leave the room, the class noticed right away that these had slightly taken on a new look. On the circles, there are an array of shapes and their names; circle, oval, square, rectangle, octagon, hexagon, heart, star, pentagon, diamond, triangle, trapezoid, and plus. Many enjoyed playing the beanbag match and toss shape game. The goal was to match the beanbag shape with the shape on the floor and toss it on. Another popular game was read and write around the room. Many enjoyed working with a friend, or on their own, to match the letters, numbers, and words (the, and, a, to) on their clipboard with the hidden ones taped up around the room. The class learned a lot about hibernation (to sleep) as we read related books and did activities. I didn't get the animal insulation experiment done with the class on Friday like I had hoped, so I have it in my plans again. This week we will continue to learn about animals (and some insects) in winter by exploring where they go and what they do if they are not hibernating. We will map the migration of the monarch butterfly and goose and talk about how the deer, rabbits and birds that adapt to winter survive where we live. This unit seems to always spark a lot of
