We will kick this unit off with studying hibernation and what it means when animals do not migrate or adapt to the changing cold weather conditions that Michigan has. We will read The Mitten and then retell the story by making our own mitten book. In science, we will simulate the feel of insulation that animals need to have in the winter months by using ice water, zip lock bags and shortening. Take advantage of the web addresses on the back! There are some great resources to further engage your preschooler exploring animals and their interesting lives. Many zoo's also have live web cams and various videos of animals. We will also be focusing on the correct names of various shapes with shape bean bag games, word wall words and puzzles. According to the weatherman, the weather will be a mix of snow and rain this week. Hopefully we will get to enjoy some snow this week. I just love sledding with the class! We will go outside each day the weather permits to enjoy the fresh air! Dress your child in full winter gear each day and please check their backpack for wet gloves and snow pants.


